#### 6. Promises Auction - Nicolle & Michal

Auction takes place March 17th. We are looking for parent donations as nothing can replace these. Team are currently two third down on parent donations from last auction. Deadline for pledges has been extended to end of the month. Reps asked to try to get five donations per class.

#### 7. Lollipop Campaign - Florence & Lisa

Our Lollipop men are funded by the PTFA. Annual funding of 9K is funded by 50% Savills and 50% Honeywell families. We run a fundraising campaign every two years where we ask people to dig deep. We use Just Giving site where you can donate. We ask anyone who values the service to make as big a contribution as they can. The 9-10k from parents is matched by Savills. We are the only state school in Wandsworth that has a Lollipop service. The campaign will run for three weeks. Match funding might be used for this? We need a lump sum as we have committed to the Council for another year for the service. The funds are segregated. We collect in advance so we know we have the funds to pay for the service.

#### 9. Duncan & Jane

Duncan - Ball space in Junior playground is 14 years old. Has run out of life so needs to be replaced. Is used for PE lessons, clubs and playtimes, so gets a lot of use. Contract has been signed £16, 800 needed from PTFA. Will be fitted in Easter Holidays weather permitting. We will arrange for a grand opening.

Jane - At Governors Meeting school's financial position was discussed. Everyone thinks because we raise a lot of money that the school is rolling in cash we are not. There has been no budget increase. Lots of changes in education are having an impact on the school . We do appreciate all the effort that everyone goes to to raise funds and in the past we have been able to fund big projects (like the garden & Honeywell House IT Suites etc). Will be relying more on donations in the future as resources will be more limited. Moving on we won't have as much money for bigger projects. Bits & pieces in the classroom will be more likely. There is the need to maintain quality of teachers and teaching assistants.
